General hazards for the Jubilee Ponds 1. Risk of drowning 2. Movement of vehicles 3. Attack by dogs 4. Infection from dog faeces 5. Injury from trees/shrubs etc. 6. Permanent sign warns of risk of 'open stretches of deep water ahead' and 'no swimming' – no entry to water permitted. Vehicle movement limited to those who have access via gate code e.g. fisherman, tractors, hedge cutters. This to be kept to a minimum. 5mph maximum speed allowed on site. Signage clearly states that dog owners are asked to keep dogs under strict control. Permanent sign states 'Dog faeces should be cleared & removed'. Dog waste bin sited at main entrance (provided by BPC) and is emptied regularly by NSDC. Inspection of site to be carried out regularly to check for any hazards such as low hanging branches, overgrown brambles etc. Working party volunteers will be made aware of all hazards before work commences. Weather to be assessed on the day of the proposed working party activity and work will be postponed in the event of adverse weather. All volunteers will be using their own equipment and will be asked to ensure that they wear the appropriate safety attire e.g. safety goggles and appropriate clothing/footwear when strimming. Where volunteers are raking grass, they will be asked to stay away from the areas of active strimming or mowing until strimming/mowing has ceased. Gardening gloves will be recommended for those using rakes and/or garden shears. First aid kit will be available. Other visitors to the pond will be asked to stay away from areas where working party activity is taking place.
